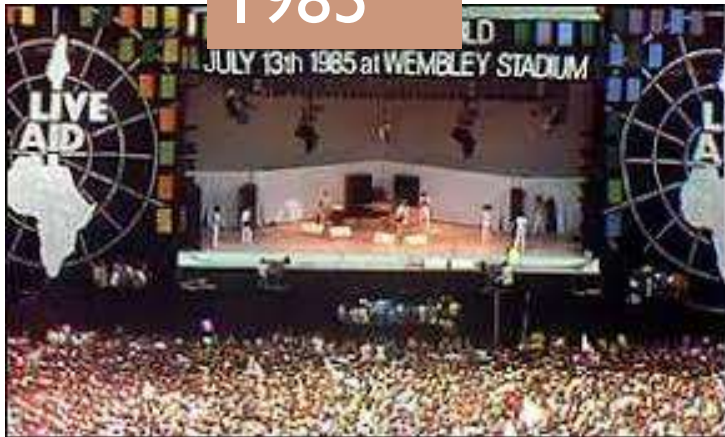

STANDING REMINDERS.

'Security' cases.

1. STANDING REMINDER with "Christmas Tree": STAFF TRANSFER LIST (S.T.L.)

The Staff Transfer List is a list of members of staff whose Personal Files carry a Standing Reminder as follows:

↑ NOT TO BE PROMOTED OR TRANSFERRED *(OR PLACED ON CONTINUING CONTRACT)
WITHOUT REFERENCE TO C.S.T.A.

* where applicable.

This Standing Reminder indicates that we hold papers which must not be retained on the file itself as they are mostly of a 'security' nature; the "Christmas Tree" is used to draw special attention and to distinguish from other types of Standing Reminder.

Each name on the S.T.L. (which is in Olive's tray) has corresponding sets of papers in orange folders, all of which are in the top drawer of Cabinet No. in Room 2122. A few, unlike the majority, are C.R.O. cases, and these are housed in the safe in Room 2122 - see also under 3. below.

There are index cards for every person, which are marked "S.T.L."
