# Anti-fascists run EDL out of town

Far-right thugs outnumbered 3:1 at Manchester rally

PAL RIGGITT, 28, from Birmingham, claims he travelled 1,000 miles to Manchester with 100 others to demonstrate against the far-right English Defence League.

TAC (English Defence League) claimed 1,000 protesters, while organisers said by most calculations they had at least 3,000 at what it called "the largest anti-fascist protest in the UK since 1945".

Paul Appleton, 28, from London, said 7,000 EDL demonstrators had come "from around the world" by 2,000 marchers from across the UK, plus supporters of the US Tea Party who had joined the English Defence League's protest.

Over 100,000 people attended the EDL's application for a march in Manchester, which was granted, but the application was withdrawn when English Defence League leaders said it could not be held on 10 October.

"The majority of marchers, particularly with regards to the English Defence League, were EDL supporters," said Mr Appleton.

"The protesters will fight until they get the government to change their laws."

Mr Appleton, who is already disillusioned with British politics, added: "I'm glad the English Defence League has been successful in getting what it wanted."

Mr Riggitt, who is originally from Cumbria, said: "It's been a great day. We've got a lot more people than the EDL have."





THE Daily Mail today takes the unprecedented step of naming five young men as murderers.

They may not have been convicted in a court of law, but police are sure that David Norris, Neil Aspin, Jamie Acourt, Gary Dobson and Luke Knight are the white youths who killed black teenager Stephen Lawrence.

We are naming them because, despite

a criminal case, a private prosecution against the five has been dropped.

Stephen Lawrence, who was stabbed to death in a racist attack almost four years ago,

and more of the five may have a long distance to the charges which have been repeatedly leveled against them so far they have steadfastly refused every opportunity to offer such a defense.

Four have refused to give any alibi for

that night in April 1993. One initially offered all alibi, but it did not stand up when police checked it out.

This week the five refused to answer any questions at the magistrate's court, citing their right to silence. A brief student was unlawfully killed, the victim of "a completely unprovoked racial attack," said the coroner.


